

Foresters' Inn

The main entrance to Foresters' Inn has level access through double opening doors.

The nearest accessible toilet is in Foresters' Inn restaurant.

Bright lighting is provided throughout the restaurant

Approximately 40% of the seating is on a raised area. This area is raised by three steps and access to this area cannot be gained any other way.

The outside terrace can be accessed as it has no steps and the ground is level. Patio chairs can be used or room is available at all tables for wheelchair access.

Large print menus are not available. Staff will be pleased to assist in any way.

The ground floor restaurant area of Foresters' Inn is near to the children's play area.

The play area consists of wooden steps/stairs to an upper deck, this leads to a slide from the upper level to the ground floor. Climbing nets and wall-mounted activity boards are also included.

The outside play area can either be accessed by a step or by a flat surface; this has a treehouse activity centre with access only by steps that lead to a slide. This area is covered with bark shavings and so wheelchair access across this is difficult.
