

Outdoor Activity Centre

Main building

The check-in area is provided with a low-level counter. A clipboard can be provided for signing documentation when required.

Entrance to the Outdoor Activity Centre is level.

There are accessible toilets, changing rooms and toilet equipped with emergency pull cord alarm.

Pathways

These are made from hard core, level and suitable for wheelchair use.

Benches or chairs are available near the activities for viewing purposes.

Paintball

The activity is run on a soft grassed arena, to facilitate falls during the activity, not conducive to wheelchair access.

Junior Quads

Special needs participants may participate if prior arrangements are made with the department.

The participating individual must be able to fully understand a safety brief and sufficiently control a 50cc junior quad bike.

Prior consultation with the department will help determine the above criteria.

Quad Bike Safari

Special needs participants may participate if prior arrangements are made with the department.

The participating individual must be able to fully understand a safety brief and sufficiently control a 250cc quad bike.

Prior consultation with the department will help determine the above criteria.

Field Archery

The activity is run on natural woodland terrain and is not conducive to wheelchair access.

Segways

The activity is run on a hardcore surface and natural woodland terrain.

Special needs participants may participate if prior arrangements are made with the department.

The participating individual must be able to fully understand a safety brief and show capabilities in riding the Segway.

Prior consultation with the department will help determine the above criteria.
