

ROBIN HOOD (LITTLE JOHN ARCHERY)

The Robin Hood area is on the perimeter of the Center Parcs site. It is reached by roadway and the final access is via a paved pathway, which has a substantial incline up to the Robin Hood archery area. This activity is suitable for guests using wheelchairs. However, wheelchair users may need assistance getting to the site.

A Mobility vehicle is available to access this activity for wheelchair users and ambulant guests who have difficulty walking substantial distances. Please note that due to space constraints, only the person who is unable to walk and two others can be carried in the vehicle. Please notify the staff at the time of booking if this service is required.

This activity would not usually be suitable for persons with no or very limited sight. Guests with partial sight can participate in this activity with verbal instruction and physical assistance from the Instructor or a member of the guest's party.

To take part in this activity it is important that all participants can follow and abide by the instructions given by the tutor.

There are no accessible toilets in this area. The nearest accessible toilets can be located at the Outdoor Activity Centre, some 2 minutes walk.

There is a small spectator viewing area.
