

Segways

The Segways Activity starts at the Outdoor Activity Centre which is sited near the perimeter of the site.

There is an accessible toilet. Lockers are also accessible.

A Mobility vehicle is available to access this area for wheelchair users and ambulant guests who have difficulty walking substantial distances. Please note that due to space constraints, only the person who is unable to walk and a carer may be able to be carried in the vehicle. Please notify the staff at the time of booking if this service is required.

The Segway practice session takes place in the vicinity of the OAC. Following this the group will move out into the village using pathways, roads and off road elements.

To take part in this activity guests require full use of arms and legs and be able to understand the safety briefing and activity instructions. They must be able to stand for 45 minutes and have the ability to balance. The ability to observe and anticipate hazards is also necessary.

Due to the style of this activity it is not suitable for guests with limited mobility or wheelchair users.
